**H**aving a hard time waiting for the big game to start on Sunday night? We have just the activity to eat up idle minutes and demonstrate your team spirit. A little tape (or glue) and scissors are all that it takes to decorate your desk, shelf or car dashboard with this paper figurine.

**NOTE:** Yes, newsprint is sufficient for this little project. But if you want a more durable keepsake, try pasting to a heavier paper before cutting.



### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut along gray lines.
2. Make mountain folds on all dotted white lines except where the feet meet the body, where you'll make a valley fold.
3. Fold tail and ears back on themselves and secure them with tape or glue.
4. Fold figure in on itself (like a box), and tape or glue gray tabs such that they're hidden by the pieces that overlap.



**Mountain fold:** The crease becomes the ridge of the mountain and the image is on the slopes.



**Valley fold:** The crease becomes the floor of the valley and the image is on the walls.
